TRAIL CARD REGULATIONS

- 1. Each rider must be 14 years of older and poses a current Identification Card as well as a Level I Trail Card to ride on the trails unescorted.
- 2. Each rider must have "Hold Harmless Agreement" and "Stable Procedures" signed and on file.
- 3. Guest passes are required for non-owners. Guests must be accompanied by Owner to ride.
- 4. Owners/Associates, 14 and older, with a Trail Card may ride string horses unescorted on trails on the North side of Highway 36.
- 5. Associates under 14 years who have a trail card may ride string horses in the Stable and Arena areas unescorted. Associates 6-15 years will be allowed to ride string horses escorted on trails only if they have demonstrated, to the wrangler, sufficient riding ability.
- 6. Associates must be at least 16 years old and possess a Level II Trail Card to take a non-trail cardholder on a trail riding string horse.
- 7. Non-trail cardholders, 14 years and older, may ride unescorted in the Stable and Arena areas only.
- 8. Non-trail cardholders may ride string horse on the trails, only when escorted by a Level II Trail cardholder
- 9. The Wrangler will note miss-use* of a string horse on the Trail Card. A second instance will result in the revocation of the trail card.
- 10. Associates 6 years and older may try for a Junior Trail Card, which will allow them to ride in the arena, and escorted on a trail.
- 11. Level I Trail Cardholders are not allowed to take any additional riders with them who do not also possess a Trail Card.
- 12. Level II Trail Cardholders may take two (2) non-Trail Cardholders on the trails, if they are 16 years or older.

**Misuse of a horse includes, but is not limited to, overworking the horse. Wrangles know the unique limits of each individual horse. Every horse is different. If you have questions, please direct them to the wrangler on duty.
